



## How to Get Involved with *Thrivent Builds Homes*

Thrivent Builds with Habitat for Humanity is the largest program of its kind in both Habitat's history and ours. We're building member engagement, growth and visibility for Thrivent Financial and capacity for Habitat by building hundreds of homes each year.

Your Lutheran Engagement Team will be coordinating Thrivent Builds opportunities in your region. Here are a few ways you can serve the community and develop new relationships in your area through this life-changing program.

### Lay the foundation:

- Learn all that you can about this program (check out the Fraternal section of FieldNet and ThriventBuilds.com).
- Attend Thrivent Builds events in your RFO.
- Help your Lutheran Engagement Team (LET) staff by suggesting candidates for a Congregational Champion who will help organize activities and be a spokesperson.

### Share the story:

- Display Thrivent Builds information in your church or at special community events (e.g., county fairs). Be there to describe the program and tell the story. Check with your LET to see which churches or events need attention.
- Talk about it during a temple talk or coffee hour.
- Take photos of work at the site. With permission from participants, add the photos to your Advisory Process presentation and/or display them in your office.
- Work with Thrivent Builds Congregational Champions to help host informational meetings about Thrivent Builds. (Use the Thrivent Builds Overview Video.)

### Put some muscle into it:

- Participate in a build. Check with your LET for available dates.
  - Invite a group of members and prospects to join you for a day at a build (don't forget Lutheran colleges or other institutions in the area).
  - Volunteer on your own at a build and meet new people.
  - Ask about being a site host during which you can meet volunteers signing in at the build site.
  - Sponsor a day at a build for your congregation.
- Sponsor lunch at a build.
